### **1. Introductions and status of each MS4**

The entities present introduced themselves and explained where their MS4 was in relation to the 6 MCMs.

Anderson has completed all 6 MCM certifications and is progressing on mapping and illicit discharge detection. Anderson purchased Operation MS4 in October 2007 to track MS4 data. Steve Goodman agreed to look into licensing agreements to allow sharing of information.

Madison County has completed all 6 MCM certifications and is progressing on mapping and illicit discharge detection. Madison County has also recently passed an ordinance for illicit discharge, construction, and post construction.

Dan Pell is new to working with Ingalls.

Since SWCD and MCCOG are not entities, but participate in the Madison County Public Outreach MOU, they also introduced themselves. Janelle Parke has resigned from SWCD, effective April 11. Alice Best will be temporarily filling the position.

### **2. Public Education and Outreach MOU**

All MS4 entities in the County (except for universities, hospitals, and prisons who are partnered with municipalities) have signed a new Public Education and Outreach MOU. Madison County has invoiced the parties who owe money and has contracted for the radio and television the same as last year. Documentation of those efforts was passed out. Anderson has had difficulty getting the school systems interested in scheduling presentations. It was suggested that the presentations may not fit into the strict curriculums the teachers have. Brad Newman and Steve Goodman agreed to approach the Anderson School Board, with the idea that any success they have could be passed on to the other school boards.

Rick Griner was able to make a presentation and documentation of that presentation will be made available.

Janelle Park passed out a summary of the SWCD public education and outreach activities.

### **3. April, Storm Water Awareness Month**

In addition to the commercials, the County issued a press release to The Herald Bulletin. An article was in the April 7, 2008 paper.
